

Application Instructions

Domestic Student LLM Application

*Separate application procedures are required of internationally educated students. Please see below.

Applicants to ÁùºÏ±¦¿â Law School's LLM program must include the following items:

- 1. ÁùºÏ±¦¿â Law School LLM application.
- Deadline. The priority application deadline for domestic students is April 1st. We have a rolling admission process; therefore, applications will continue to be accepted after this date.
- 3. Official law school transcripts.
- 4. Statement of Purpose. Please explain why you wish to pursue an LLM and how the degree will further your career plans. You are also encouraged to include any information you consider to be useful in the admission evaluation process.
- 5. At least one letter of recommendation is required, and up to three letters will be accepted. Letters should address an applicant's academic performance and potential.

International Student LLM Application

For the purpose of admission, an international student is defined as a student who received their law degree outside the United States or will be in the United States on a non-immigrant visa. This specifically refers to the Student (F) and Exchange Visitor (J) visas.

International applicants are required to submit the following items:

- 1. Completed ÁùºÏ±l¿â Law School LLM application.
- 2. Deadline. The priority application deadline is April 1st for the fall semester. We have a rolling admission process; therefore, applications will continue to be accepted after this date.
- 3. Statement of Purpose. Please explain why you wish to pursue an LLM and how the degree will further your career plans. You are also encouraged to include any information you consider to be useful in the admission evaluation process.
- 4. An LSAC LLM Credential Assembly Service report is required for applicants who are defined as an international student. Transcripts and TOEFL or IELTS scores must be sent to the LSAC LLM Credential Assembly Service to be evaluated by the International Transcript Authentication and Evaluation Service. All services are offered only online at LSAC.org.
- TOEFL or IELTS scores are required for applicants whose native language is not English. An official copy of the test report must be sent by the testing service directly to LSAC. These scores will be included in the foreign credential assembly service at LSAC.
- 6. At least one letter of recommendation is required, and up to three letters will be accepted. Letters should address an applicant's academic performance and potential. Letters of recommendation may be sent to the LLM Credential Assembly Service.

Bar Admission Statement:

Admission to ÁuºÏ±l¿â Law School does not guarantee admission to the bar of any state. In addition to a bar examination, there are character, fitness, and other qualifications for admission to the bar in every U.S. jurisdiction. Applicants are encouraged to determine the requirements for any jurisdiction in which they intend to seek admission by contacting the jurisdiction. Addresses for all relevant agencies are available through the National Conference of Bar Examiners.
