Domestic Student MJ Application

Applicants to ÁùºÏ±l¿â Law School's MJ program must include the following items:

1. ÁùºÏ±l¿â Law School MJ application.

- Deadline. The priority application deadline is June 1st for fall semester. We have a rolling admission process, therefore, applications will continue to be accepted after these dates.
- Statement of Purpose. Please explain why you wish to pursue an MJ and how the degree will further your career plans. You are also encouraged to include any information you consider to be useful in the admission evaluation process.
- At least one letter of recommendation is required, and up to three letters will be accepted. Letters should address an applicant's academic performance and potential.
- 5. Copy of graduate examination scores (GRE, GMAT, LSAT, if available)

International Student MJ Application

For the purpose of admission, an international student is defined as a student who received their law degree outside the United States, or will be in the United States on a non-immigrant visa. This specifically refers to the Student (F) and Exchange Visitor (J) visas.

International applicants are required to submit the following items:

- 1. Completed ÁùºÏ±¦¿â Law School MJ application.
- 2. Deadline. The priority application deadline is June 1st for the fall semester. We have a rolling admission process, therefore, applications will continue to be accepted after these dates.
- Statement of Purpose. Please explain why you wish to pursue an MJ and how the degree will further your career plans. You are also encouraged to include any information you consider to be useful in the admission evaluation process
- Official academic transcripts.
- 5. TOEFL or IELTS scores are required for applicants whose native language is not English. ÁùºĨ±l¿â Law requires a TOEFL iBT score of 80.
- At least one letter of recommendation is required, and up to three letters will be accepted. Letters should address an applicant's academic performance and potential.
