The B.A. in History requires 37 credit hours. Students may earn these credits by taking all history courses, the single major in history option, or by pursuing the $28+9$ option, the cross-disciplinary option for double majors.

- The single major in history requires students to complete the major by earning 37 credit hours in history courses.
- The cross-disciplinary option for double majors requires earning 28 credit hours in history courses and counting 9 credit hours ( $100+$ level courses) from a second related major toward the B.A. in History.
- For either option, at least 15 hours in history must be completed at Drake. See also www.drake.edu/historyl.
- Up to three hours of internship credit (HIST 195) may count as elective credit, depending on the nature of the internship experience.
